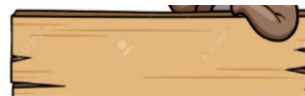
Royal Fun

... that there is a special Animals in War Dedication in Ottawa?

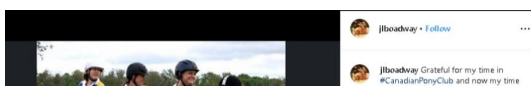
