Please submit the following forms. In order to ensure accuracy of information (i.e., competitor names) ensure forms are legible either typed or printed in BLOCK letters – the pdf has been formatted as a fillable file. Signature lines must be completed either with manual signatures (scanned or mailed) or electronic signatures (in pdf).

Complete packages include

1. Team Application
2. Chaperone application (one chaperone per 4 members/4-member team).
3. Competitor application (one form per competitor)
4. Participant agreement (one for every member and chaperone)
5. Chaperone publicity agreement (one for every chaperone)
6. Entry Fee: \$425 per participant and chaperone. This fee includes accommodation, activities and meals from Friday evening to Sunday evening.
7. Clothing order will follow this package.

Method of Payment

E-TRANSFERS accepted. Send to corpcpayment@gmail.com – indicate your Region and Contact person's name clearly in the message area.

Regional Cheques are fine – made out to Central Ontario Region Pony Club. Postdated cheques dated later than August 15, 2022 will **not** be accepted.

- inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated;
- coaches, chaperones and competition officials have the authority to exert positive discipline over members as they deem necessary; respecting the dignity of the individual. The tone is corrective rather than punitive.
- a member's use or possession of illegal or controlled substances, alcohol or tobacco products are prohibited for the duration of any competition and will result in disciplinary action;
- a coach or chaperone's use or possession of illegal or controlled substances or alcohol are prohibited for the duration of any competition and will result in disciplinary action.

I understand that:

Any or all of the following steps will be followed in sequence, but there is no time requirement between steps. Beyond Step 2, the coach and chaperone will concur. Beyond Step 4, input will be sought from the National Chair of the Discipline, the National Disciplines Chair or the National Chair.

- Step 1. Verbal reprimand.
- Step 2. An explanation and apology to teammates.
- Step 3. Written reprimand.
- Step 4. Elimination from a class or phase of competition.
- Step 5. Disqualification from entire competition.
- Step 6. Removal from a competition site and being sent home early at personal expense.
- Step 7. Presentation at a discipline hearing

COVID/Pandemic Considerations

As National Quiz is being held in Ontario for 2022, the organizers will be following the guidelines/rules as set forth by the Ontario government.

Please make sure you/your competitors are aware of travel restrictions and obligations from point-of-origin into Ontario.

As of this time, there are few COVID-related restrictions in Ontario. However, COVID is not gone and we cannot predict what will happen in the Fall. So, please consider the following:

1. Written into our contract with the hotel is a clause that will refund our payment to the facility in the event of another lock-down, or situation beyond our control that forces us or the hotel to cancel the event. In this case, we will still try to hold National Quiz on a virtual platform and refund competitors as much of their registration fees as possible (less the cost of virtual Quiz, which was priced at \$15/competitor in 2021).
2. If you are sick, stay home. However, if you can provide proof that your symptoms are not COVID-related or contagious via at least 1 negative test a minimum of 24 hours from the start of the event and/or a doctor's note, we may invite you to come. We will try to refund fees, subject to a 10% administration fee; however, if the hotel charges us for your meals and accommodation, we may not be able to refund fees.
3. At this time, masks are not mandatory, but we will have a supply available and we respect everyone's right to wear, or not wear (subject to government rules) a mask.
4. Teams will be sharing rooms – up to 4/room. If this is not acceptable to certain members or Regions, please let us know. Surcharges may apply.
5. We will keep Regions up-to-date if anything changes with regards to COVID, restrictions, etc. If you have questions, feel free to contact Laurie Blake, whose information appears on page 4 of this document.
